**NOTICE** - Wesley Smith will make the following oral motion in court today. I'm filing it with the clerk to ensure there is a record of my request.

**COMES NOW** Wesley C. Smith, and makes this Motion to be allowed to have a tape record all hearings in this matter and states as follows:

1. The Wesley Smith is without an attorney (or funds to hire one) and thus must handle the case himself. Mr. Smith cannot afford to pay for a transcript so will need to submit a Statement Of Facts for use in an appeal.
2. Mr. Smith has ADD that will make it impossible for him to make accurate notes while presenting his case or to submit a complete Statement Of Facts based on memory.
3. Federal laws require the court to make "reasonable accommodations" for people with disabilities. Allowing the use of a recording in place of notes is a reasonable accommodation.
4. Mr. Mark Young who has donated his services to be a court reporter for two of the state court hearings may be present today to record this hearing.
