MOTION TO AMEND TEMPORARY ~~CUSTODY~~ <sup>Visitation</sup>

Comes now the Petitioner/ Co-Respondent, Wesley C. Smith, and Respondent/Co-Petitioner Cheri Smith, who jointly move this Court to grant their Motion to Amend Temporary Visitation. In support of this Motion, the Co-Petitioners state:

1. That an Agreed Order for Temporary Visitation was entered by this Court on October 4, 2003;
2. That this Order mandated that neither party could take the minor child, Liam, out of the Commonwealth of Virginia;
3. That the October 4<sup>th</sup> Order expired on October 18, 2003;
4. That this matter is set for trial on July 10, 2003 at 9:00 a.m.;
5. That the parties believe that it is in the child's best interests to have contact with his extended family;
6. That the parties have reached the following agreement as to a visitation schedule for the dates of Friday, April 11, 2003 through Sunday, April 20, 2003, pendente lite, pending trial in this matter:

A. That the Petitioner, Wesley C. Smith, shall have visitation, pendente lite, with the Child

from Friday, April 11, 2003 through Sunday April 20, 2003; and it is further

A. That the Petitioner, Wesley C. Smith may take the Child to Michigan during his visitation

time from Friday April 11, 2003 through Sunday April 20, 2003;

WHEREFORE, the Co-petitioners respectfully request that the Court entered an Amended Temporary Visitation Order for the period April 11, 2003 through April 20, 2003.
